Research Grant – Coagulation

§ 1

CSL Behring provides research grants in the area of coagulation. Recipients will be awarded with the CSL Behring - Prof. Heimburger Award.

§ 2

CSL Behring will provide 5 start-up grants of € 20.000 on an annual basis. No matching or other funding is a prerequisite. The grants will be available for preclinical and/or clinical research in the area of coagulation.

Younger clinicians, who hold an MD with a full-time faculty position and who wish to establish an independent research project in the field of coagulation, are welcome to apply.

It is expected that the person indicated as the investigator for this grant application is the individual who is personally and actively responsible for the conduct of the research.

The award of this grant depends on the receipt of an application of high scientific merit.

In case that there are no or fewer appropriate candidates, CSL Behring will suspend the grant award or award fewer grants, respectively.

§ 3

The grant will consist of an award certificate and a lump sum of € 20.000.

§ 4

All applications received by October of each year will be forwarded to a selection committee consisting of four scientifically renowned clinicians in the field of coagulation.

The selection committee will have three months to review applications based on scientific merit. Applications will initially be screened, and the 10 applications deemed to have the highest chance of success will be asked to submit a more detailed (3-4 pages) description of their research project. Based on their evaluation of the detailed submission, the selection committee will inform CSL Behring of their decision by the end of May of each year. CSL Behring will then notify the recipients. The grants will formally be awarded during the WFH/ISTH respectively.

At the end of each cycle, the recipient will be given the opportunity to present the results obtained at CSL Behring, Marburg, Germany.

§ 5

The grant will be paid via bank transfer into an institutional account.

§ 6

CSL Behring reserves the right to, at its discretion, change or terminate the grant program.

§ 7

The statutes will come into effect on September 1, 2007.
